The Retail Manager will be responsible for the operation and management of all aspects of butchery, including product selection, ordering, preparation, display, packaging, and sales of fresh meats to its' customers.

The successful candidate will also oversee the Butchers Shop and will be competent in preparing fresh meat for sale. You will be able to advise customers on suitable cuts to meet their requirements.

If you are a skilled Butcher, have leadership skills and a thirst for success then we could be the right company for you. A proven track record of a similar position and previous experience working in the industry is essential.

Responsibilities

The Retail Manager duties and responsibilities will include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Leading an established retail team
- Ensuring compliance with health & safety legislation
- Motivate staff to achieve sales targets
- Overseeing stock control
- Product ordering / liaison with head office
- Dealing with customers
- Ensuring the safe & legal operation of the store, daily
